EMPLOYMENT APPLICATIONS.**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Shenango recognizes the need for efficient management of employment applications received for various positions within the township; and


**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to establish a clear policy regarding the expiration of employment applications to ensure that the township's hiring processes remain current and effective; and


**WHEREAS**, after careful consideration and review, the Township Board has determined that setting an expiry date for employment applications will serve the best interests of the township and its residents.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of Shenango Township, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania that:

1. Effective immediately, all applications for employment submitted to the Township of Shenango shall expire one (1) year from the date of submittal.
2. The Township Manager or their designee is hereby authorized to implement and enforce this resolution.
3. If any provision of this resolution is held to be invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect the remaining provisions, which shall remain in full force and effect.
4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
